A Note to **International Baccalaureate** Students, Parents, Teachers, Counselors, and Administrators:

This Credit Policies Guide is intended to aid high school students in their educational planning. The guide is a venue wherein colleges and universities state clearly their policies in granting college credit for successful completion of International Baccalaureate (IB) examinations in high school. The guide also represents certification of these policies to the Minnesota Department of Education and to the Minnesota State Legislature.

International Baccalaureate Program policies of many Minnesota institutions of higher learning are represented in this guide. We recognize that the guide may be incomplete both in the information provided and in the institutions covered. With the publication of this information at regular intervals in the future, we expect that colleges and universities will update their policies and move toward a more specific indication of course equivalent credits. Institutions not included in this guide may give credit, but have not made their policies available for this edition of the guide. Institution policy changes are current as of December 1, 2007. You may want to call the college contact to verify credits available upon successful completion of IB exams.

Institutions that are part of Minnesota State Colleges and Universities (MnSCU) adopt a policy establishing common practices among these institutions for awarding credit based on student performance on International Baccalaureate examinations.

Minnesota State Colleges and Universities International Baccalaureate Policy Changes in Process

The Minnesota State Colleges and Universities have long had a policy specifying that students attending system institutions will be awarded credit for completion of the International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma or for individual IB Higher Level examinations. Currently, revisions in Board Policy 3.16 International Baccalaureate Credit are under discussion and new System Procedure 3.16.1 International Baccalaureate Credit, which will guide implementation of the policy, is being developed. While specific policy language changes are being discussed, institutions have been instructed to award credit for scores of 4 or higher on all IB examinations, consistent with Minnesota Statutes Chapter 120B, Section 13 (M.S. 120B.13).
